NOTICE OF RACE

THE NEW GEN F18 REGATTA WELCOMED BY "LES AILES DE ST-TROPEZ" WILL BE HELD FROM OCTOBER THE 19TH TO OCTOBER THE 22TH 2024, IN SAINT-TROPEZ, BAIE DES CANOUBIERS - FRANCE. THE EVENT IS ORGANIZED JOINTLY BY THE YACHT CLUB DE SAINT TROPEZ AND NACRA SAILING

OBJECTIVE: PROVIDE THE YOUTH INTERNATIONAL TEAMS THE OPPORTUNITY TO APPRECIATE WHAT COMES NEXT AND PROVIDE THEM A UNIQUE CHANCE TO SHOW THE F18 CLASS THEIR TALENT IN A SPECTACULAR AND COMPETITIVE TOURNAMENT.

THE WINNER WILL BE REPRESENTING NACRA AT THE 2025 F18 WORLDS ON A NACRA EVOLUTION PROVIDED BY NACRA SAILING.

1. RULES

- I. THE EVENT IS GOVERNED BY THE RULES AS DEFINED IN THE 2021-2024 RACING RULES OF SAILING
- II. BEYOND THE RULES OF PRIORITY, EVERY RIDER HAS TO DO HIS BEST TO AVOID COLLISION.

2. ADVERTISING

- I. THE COMPETITORS WILL BE REQUIRED TO DISPLAY ADVERTISING CHOSEN AND SUPPLIED BY THE ORGANISATION AUTHORITY
- II. THE BOATS MAY BE CARRYING GPS TRACKING UNITS, ONBOARD CAMERAS AND/OR SOUND EQUIPMENT WHILE AFLOAT (OR AN EQUIVALENT DUMMY).

3. SAILING INSTRUCTION

- I. THE SIS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT REGISTRATION AND IN DIGITAL VERSION AT FOLLOWING WEB ADRESS [HTTPS://NACRASAILING.COM/](https://nacrasailing.com/) AT THE LATEST, THE DAY PRIOR THE EVENT



4. COMMUNICATION

I. THE ONLINE NOTICE BOARD CAN BE FOUND UNDER THE FOLLOWING WHATSAPP GROUP. ALL COMMUNICATION WILL BE PERFORMED THROUGH THIS CHANNEL.



II. EXCEPT IN AN EMERGENCY, A BOAT (WHILE RACING) SHALL NOT MAKE VOICE OR DATA COMMUNICATION THAT IS NOT AVAILABLE TO ALL BOATS.

III. COACHING, WHILE ON THE WATER, IS FULLY FORBIDDEN. THE COACHES MUST STAY AWAY FROM THE SAILORS WHILE ON THE WATER, UNLESS THEY HAVE ASKED TO BE PART OF THE ORGANISATION TO HELP WITH SAFETY ON THE WATER. ON THAT OCCASION THERE SHOULD BE NO COACHING DURING THE COMPETITION, FOR FAIRNESS AND EQUITY

5. ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION

I. 16 TO 20 TEAMS WILL BE SELECTED

II. THE EVENT IS OPEN TO ANY TEAMS AGED BETWEEN 17 & 23 YEARS OLD FROM ANY NATIONS. THEY HAVE TO BE BORN AFTER 31 DEC 2002 AND BEFORE 31 DEC 2007, IN ORDER TO STILL BE YOUTH FOR THE 2025 F18 WORLDS.

III. FROM NOW ON, ALL CANDIDATURES SHALL BE MADE BEFORE THE 15TH OF AUGUST 2024 AT [HTTPS://NACRASAILING.COM/](https://nacrasailing.com/)

IV. SAILORS HAVING CANDIDATED WILL HAVE THEIR FINAL CONFIRMATION ON THE 20TH OF AUGUST AFTER THE SELECTION OF THE JURY COMPOSED OF NACRA, YCST & TEAM RIDERS'S MEMBERS, BASED MOSTLY ON PREVIOUS RANKINGS AND EXPERIENCES. IF NO UNANIMITY SHALL BE FOUND, A DRAW WILL BE PERFORMED.

V. AFTER CONFIRMATION, PAYMENT SHALL BE MADE BEFORE THE 31ST OF AUGUST FOR FINAL REGISTRATION

6. ENTRY FEES

I. THE ENTRY FEES ARE 350 EUROS PER TEAM

II. COMPETITORS ENTRY FEES INCLUDE: LUNCH, T-SHIRT, BIBS, GPS, AND F18 NACRA EVOLUTIONS CHARTER BOATS.



7. ACCOMODATION

- I. ONLY ONE ACCOMMODATION IS BOOKABLE WITH THE ORGANISATION. "LOU RIOU" SAINT TROPEZ, 5 MIN WALK FROM THE CLUB.
- II. FEES ARE 50€ PER NIGHT PER PERSON IN HALF PENSION (BREAKFAST AND DINER) FOR A DOUBLE BEDROOM OR QUADRUPLE BEDROOM.
- III. TEAMS MUST PRE-BOOK THEIR ROOMS DURING THE REGISTRATION ON THE WEBSITE [HTTPS://NACRASAILING.COM/](https://nacrasailing.com/) BEFORE THE 15TH OF AUGUST.

8. CHARTER BOAT

- I. A NUMBER OF 4 NACRA EVOLUTIONS WILL BE PROVIDED BY NACRA SAILING INCLUDED IN THE 350 EUROS OF THE INSCRIPTION.
- II. A 300 EUROS DEPOSIT IN CASH WILL BE ASKED PER TEAM TO COVER ANY DAMAGE IN THE OCCURENCE OF ANY EVENT LEADING OF THE DAMAGE OF THE CHARTER BOATS.
- III. SETTINGS: BOAT WILL BE PREPARED AND RIGGED IN THE MORNING BY NACRA SAILING TEAM. IT IS FULLY FORBIDDEN TO CHANGE THE RIGGING SETTINGS, AS A VERY LITTLE TIME WILL BE PERMITTED TO CHANGE BOAT, AND AS FAIRNESS AND EQUITY IS AT THE HEART OF THE EVENT. MAY THE BEST WIN ...

9. SUPPORT BOAT

- I. SUPPORT BOAT NEEDS TO MAKE A FORMAL REQUEST AT LAST@YCST.FR OIN ORDER TO BE ALLOWED ON THE WATER
- II. NO COACHING IS ALLOWED ON THE WATER
- III. SUPPORT BOAT CAN HELP THE ORGANISATION FOR EXTRA SAFETY OR TO CARRY FEW SPECTATORS DEPENDING OF THE SIZE OF THE BOAT

- I. FRIDAY 18TH UNTIL 5PM - REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION
- II. FRIDAY 6PM: DRAW FOR THE POOL DEFINITION ACCORDING TO RANKING
- III. SATURDAYS 19TH FROM 11AM - TO MONDAY 21TH - RACING

11. FLEET DEVISION

I. ON THE FRIDAY THE 18TH AFTER THE CONFIRMATION OF INSCRIPTION, A DRAW WILL BE PERFORMED TO DEFINIE BETWEEN 4 TO 5 POOL.

II. THE DRAW WILL BE PERFORMED WITH 2 POTS. POT 1 WITH THE HIGHEST RANKING (8 TO 10 TEAMS). POT 2 WITH THE LOWEST RANKING (8 TO 10 TEAMS)

III. FOR EACH POOL (4 TO 5), 2 TEAMS WILL BE DRAW IN POT 1, 2 TEAMS IN POT 2

13. WEIGHT

- I. THE MINIMUM COMBINED CREW WEIGHT MUST BE 115 KGS.
- II. CREWS WEIGHING LESS THAN 150 KG COMBINED SHALL CARRY EXTRA WEIGHT EQUAL TO HALF THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THEIR ACTUAL WEIGHT AND 150 KG
- III. DEPENDING OF THE AVERAGE CREW WEIGHT OF THE REGATTA, THE 150 KG COULD BE LOWERED DOWN TO AVOID CARRYING OUT TOO MUCH EXTRA WEIGHT ON THE BOAT.

14. PENALTY SYSTEM

- I. PENALTY IS A 360°, TO BE PERFORMED AS SOON AS THERE IS FREE ROOM WITHOUT ENDANGERING THE OTHER BOAT.
- II. THIS IS A FAIR AND GENTLEMAN REGATTA, WE WILL KNOW IF A MISTAKE HAS BEEN DONE, AND WILL ASK YOU TO REPAIR STRAIGHT AWAY. IF NOT SEEN BY THE JURY, PLEASE BE HONEST AND PERFORM THE REPAIR.
- III. CONTACT = DSQ FOR THE 2 BOATS :) IF COULD BE AVOIDED

15. THE JURY

- I. HE IS THE KING, AND WILL DO ITS BEST FOR EVERYONE TO HAVE FUN
- II. DIRECT JURY SHOULD BE PERFORMED ON THE WATER UNLESS PRECISED OTHERWISE.
- III. NO PROTEST AFTER SAILING UNLESS DECIDED BY THE JURY

16. DATA PROTECTION

- I. IMAGE AND APPEARANCE RIGHTS : PARTICIPATING IN THE COMPETITION, THE COMPETITOR AND HIS LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE AUTHORISE THE ORGANISATION, AND THEIR SPONSORS TO USE FREE OF CHARGE HIS IMAGE AND HIS NAME, TO SHOW AT ANY TIME (DURING AND AFTER THE COMPETITION) STATIC OR MOVING PICTURES, FILMS OR TV RECORDING, AS WELL AS OTHER REPRODUCTION FROM HIMSELF DONE DURING THE COMPETITION, AND THIS ON ANY SUPPORT AND FOR ANY USE RELATED TO THE PROMOTION OF THEIR ACTIVITIES.
